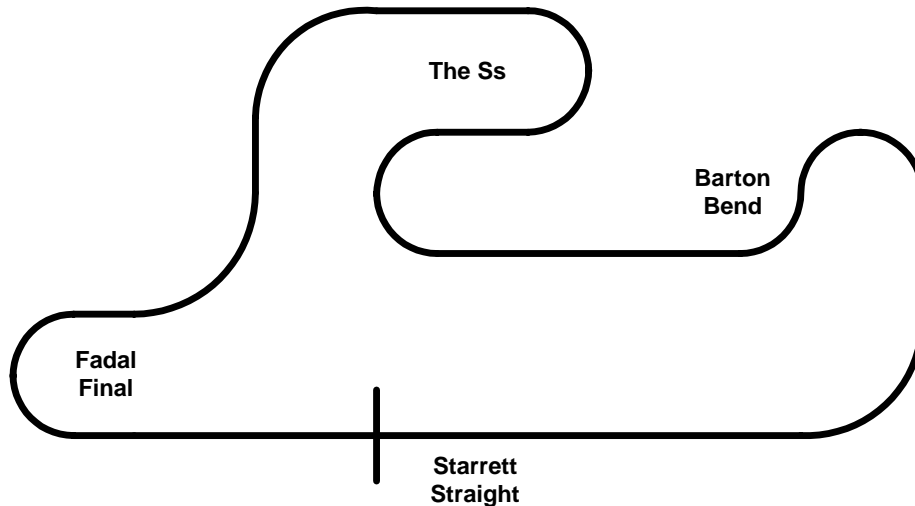

However, Santamarina ran away with the win when the RedLine duo got caught up in traffic and failed to put in clean laps to catch the crafty Cuban. "We're in the final stretch now so either you come to race or leave it at home." Said 3rd place finisher Barnes who narrowly lost to his teammate.

Gary had his run but is still resting in the top spot by consistent top two finishes after his hat trick at Oppenheimer. Santamarina is only 6 points behind with Barnes and Hester within 15. Will it be a sprint to the finish between Stephenson and Santamarina or will Barnes, Hester and Morrison sneak back to take the top three?
